3. The applicant must attend an Idaho college, university, technical or vocational school.

Submission Requirements

1. List **School Organizations and Activities** to which you have contributed significantly, stating any office held during your sophomore, junior and senior years in high school.
2. List **Church and Community Activities** to which you have contributed significantly during your sophomore, junior and senior years in high school.
3. Write a one-page (typed, single spaced) **Essay** in which you include the following:
 - a. A brief introduction of yourself and a description of your college plans;
 - b. An explanation of a unique or special financial need;
 - c. A specific description of your involvement and contribution to Key Club. Include work projects, your length of membership and attendance record.
4. A statement of verification from your Key Club faculty advisor as to the number of service hours you have contributed.
